# Updates: City Manager; Police Chief; Councilors; and Mayor

City Manager Burgener explained on November 18 there will be an in person Public Meetings Law Training in St. Helens for Council from 1:00pm to 3:30pm. He gave an updated on Luma Vista. He asked about getting Councils feedback regarding committees and liaisons.
