RESOLUTION NO. 20-19

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR ENTRANCE OF SCAPPOOSE GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, Oregonians in urban and rural areas of the state have been infected with the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared that the COVID-19 virus is a global pandemic; and

WHEREAS, City Council declared a that a state of emergency exists within the City of Scappoose due to the COVID-19 Pandemic in Resolution 20-18; and

WHEREAS, ORS 401.309 allows the City to establish procedures to prepare for and carry out any activity to prevent, minimize, respond to or recover from an emergency; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to establish a policy for entrance of all Scappoose government buildings by members of the public during the COVID-19 Pandemic that, at a minimum, meets the directives of Governor Brown and the Center for Disease Control's Guidance for Employers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The City Council of the City of Scappoose hereby declares that any member of the public who enters a Scappoose government building during the COVID-19 Pandemic is subject to having their temperature taken upon arrival.
- 2. This policy for entering Scappoose government buildings will remain in place so long as the directives of Governor Brown are in effect and the City is in a state of emergency.
- 3. This Resolution is effective immediately upon passage.
