## Fall Street Sweeping October 17 through December

Public Works will start the Fall street sweeping schedule on **Monday, October 17 through December**. During this time, Public Works will be street sweeping each week. The primary focus will be on **curbed streets**, as these streets have catch basins that are prone to clogging from debris.

#### Schedule

Mondays – West of Hwy 30 and South of EM Watts

Tuesdays - West of Hwy 30 and North of EM Watts


Wednesdays – East of Hwy 30 and South of Elm Street

Thursdays - East of Hwy 30 and North of Elm Street

#### Please Note

- Raking or blowing leaves/debris from your property into the street is <u>prohibited</u> and can risk damaging the Street Sweeper.
- Crews may have to respond to emergencies and may not reach your street on a scheduled day.
- Please have any vehicles, trash bins, basketball hoops, or any other items that may obstruct access **removed** from the **curbed streets** on the day of your zone (see map).
