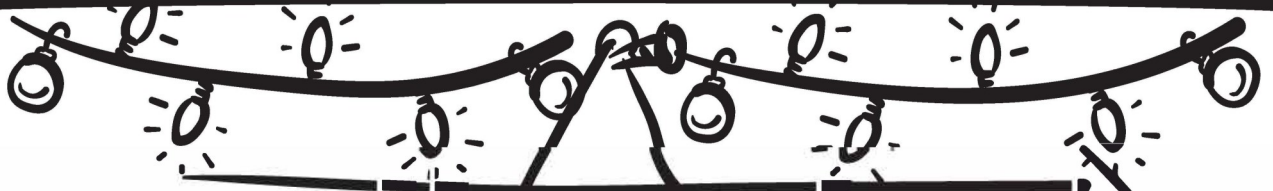




HOLIDAY LIGHT FIGHT!

Columbia County Transfer Station - 1601 Railroad Ave., St. Helens

BRING to HHW Events:

- ◆ Lawn / Garden Chemicals
- ◆ Herbicides / Pesticides
- ◆ Pool / Spa Chemicals
- ◆ Light Ballasts
 - remove from light fixture
- ◆ Fluorescent Tubes
- ◆ Art / Hobby Chemicals
- ◆ Solvents / Thinners
- ◆ Items Containing Mercury
- ◆ Propane Cylinders
- ◆ Compressed Gas Cylinders
- ◆ Batteries
 - all types and applications
- ◆ Cleaners / Detergents
- ◆ Poisons
- ◆ Ammunition
- ◆ Fireworks / Flares
- ◆ Gas / Diesel / Fuels

Bring product in original container
and **Secure Your Load**

DO NOT BRING to HHW Events:

- ◆ Asbestos
- ◆ Garbage / Trash
- ◆ Liquids in Containers **Larger Than 5 Gallons**
- ◆ Unwanted / Unused Medicines or Pharmaceuticals
 - drop off at the County Sheriff's Office

RECYCLE these items at the Transfer Station (during business hours):

- ◆ Latex and Acrylic Paint, Oil-Based Paint, Enamels, Stains, Lacquers, Shellacs, Varnishes, and Primers
- ◆ Used Motor Oil and Antifreeze
- ◆ Electronics
 - TVs, computers, monitors, etc.

MEDICAL SHARPS:

must be in sealed, OSHA approved,
puncture-proof containers.
(available at the Transfer Station scale house)

For All OTHER MATERIALS:

including Commercial Generators (CEG) and liquids in containers larger than 5 gallons: call Mark Haynes with ACT Enviro (971.303.2979) at least 2 weeks prior to an event for an appointment.
