Here is how the contest works...

The Oregon Mayors Association (OMA) "If I Were Mayor, I Would..." Student Contest, is open to local students enrolled in school or being home-schooled for the 2025-2026 school year.

There are three categories:

**Elementary School (grade 4-5)** - Posters Contest (Photo of poster can be PNG, JPEG, or PDF files)

**Middle School (grade 6-8)** - Essay Contest (Word, PDF, PowerPoint or online essay format)

**High School (grades 9-12)** - Digital Media Presentations (MP4 or online video format)

Local winners will receive a Fred Meyer gift card and lunch with Mayor Backus.


# Help spread the love of literacy to 1,400 local early learners.
