

RESOLUTION NO. 593

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 321 REGARDING CRITERIA TO CANCEL EXCESSIVE WATER BILLS DUE TO LEAKS.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 321 on May 7, 1984, regarding the criteria to be used to cancel excessive water bills due to leaks, and


WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend Resolution No. 321, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT: Resolution No. 321 be amended as follows:


1. Where residential water bills are excessive due to a leak in the water service between the meter and the building the following policy shall apply;
 - A. The water bill shall be adjusted to the average bill over the past 12 months plus 1/2 of the amount above the average, providing that no adjustment will be made for water lost more than seven (7) days beyond notification of a possible leak.
 - B. Proof of a leak and repair must accompany the request for adjustment.
