## City of Scappoose Newsletter ~ December 2017


Working with the City of Scappoose, Scappoose Bay Watershed Council was awarded a Bonneville Power Grant (BPA) of \$361,678 to implement stream restoration activities including the portions of the South Scappoose Creek near Veteran's Park, the parcel just upstream from the park and the parcel south of JP West Road on the west side of the creek. These activities will address the incised channel, severe erosion, lack of a continuous riparian corridor and disconnections from historic side-channels, that has resulted in a loss of habitat, excessive stream temperatures and erosion concerns.

This project will be beneficial in several ways. First, it will enhance fish habitat. Additionally, it will make the creek more accessible to the public, as well as create a larger floodway that will help reduce flooding of adjoining properties during flood events.

The project is scheduled to complete designs and permitting in Winter 2017-18, with construction in mid-to-late summer 2018. Vegetation planting will occur between November 2018 and March 2019.

The City is contributing over \$75,000 to the project. The SBWC will be working on outreach, and education and expects to have volunteer opportunities for community members interested in restoration – particularly with the native vegetation planting activities. Additional project partners include the Columbia Soil and Water Conservation District, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board.
