

## Scappoose Police Department Media Release May 24, 2023

O4262023 Police were dispatched to a cold theft in the 52000 block of SE 3<sup>rd</sup> St. It was reported a male juvenile stole a bicycle from the location. In a separate incident, it was also reported that the same juvenile suspect, assaulted another juvenile and stole their bicycle too. This case has been referred to the Columbia County Juvenile Department for pending charges.

O4272023 Police took a report of a cold theft in the 33000 block of SW Chinook Plz. It was reported that propane tanks were stolen from the business at the location. This case is pending further investigation and suspect identification.

O4282023 Police were dispatched to a death investigation in the 33000 block of SW Meadowbrook Dr. Following the investigation, it was determined that the cause of death was of natural causes.

O4292023 Police took a report of a criminal mischief in the 51000 block of Columbia River Hwy. It was reported that an unknown male subject entered Fred Meyer and lit a flare and fled the scene. This case is pending further investigation and suspect identification.

O5012023 Police took a report of a theft in the 33000 block of SW Chinook Plz. It was reported that an unknown suspect stole a chainsaw from the location. This case is pending further investigation and suspect identification.

O5012023 Police were dispatched to the report of a stalking complaint in the 52000 block of Columbia River Hwy. The victim reported that the suspects were following her while filming her actions causing the victim to be alarmed. This case is pending further investigation.

O5012023 Police took a report of a juvenile situation which involved the request for nude photos. The situation resolved itself and no criminal action was taken.

O5032023 Police responded to the report of stolen vehicle in the 34000 block of NE Heron Meadows Dr. The victim reported that as she was dropping her children off and in the time span of approximately 4 minutes of being away from the car it was stolen. A citizen stated they had seen the stolen vehicle and suspects driving the vehicle later that morning. The private citizen provided video evidence to law enforcement. The stolen vehicle was recovered by Portland Police Bureau the next day.

It was reported that the men were throwing drinks, screaming, threatening to pull a gun and shoot the employees and refusing to leave. The suspects left the theater before law enforcement arrived. An area check was done and the suspects were not located.

O5052023 Police responded to the report of a harassment in the 52000 block of Columbia River Hwy. It was reported that a subject entered the business and threatened an employee by stating they were employed by the CIA and if they didn't stop bullying their relative. This case has been referred for possible criminal charges.

O5052023 Police were dispatched to the report of a two-vehicle accident that occurred in a parking lot. The damage was minimum and not injuries were reported. Information was exchanged between the drivers and the scene was cleared.
