

Scappoose Police Department Media Release SEPTEMBER 13, 2022

O8242022 Police performed CPR on an unconscious female subject who was suffering from an apparent overdose. Scappoose Fire Department arrived on scene and took over the lifesaving attempts. The female subject was revived and transported to a Portland area hospital.

O8252022 Following a traffic stop, Leslie Jackson, 50, of Salem, was taken into custody on an outstanding felony warrant. The warrant was out of Marion County for Violating a Court Stalking Order. Mr. Jackson was transported to jail where he was lodged on his charges.

O8282022 Police initiated a traffic stop of vehicle after witnessing it drive at excessive speeds in the area of Columbia River Hwy. and NW Laurel St. Following the traffic stop, Jordan Wilhelm, 38, of Rainier, was taken into custody for DUII. Mr. Wilhelm was transported to the Columbia County Jail where he was booked and released on his charge.

O8312022 Police were dispatched to the report of a theft in progress at Fred Meyer. It was the suspect had pushed a grocery cart full of unpaid items through the parking lot to the back of a near by building. When law enforcement arrived they witnessed the suspect loading several backpacks up with items from the grocery cart. The backpacks still had security tags attached to them. Police identified the women as Desiree Hodges, 30, of Portland. Ms. Hodges admitted

to stealing the items and was sorry for doing so. Ms. Hodges was placed under arrest and transported to the Columbia County Jail where she was booked and released on her charges.

09012022 Police were dispatched to the report of a death in the 32000 block of SW Crystal Springs Crt. CPR attempts were made but were unsuccessful.

O9042022 Police assisted multiple outside agencies with the arrest of 3 juveniles for Attempt to Elude, Possession of a Stolen Firearm and Reckless Driving. It was reported that the vehicle was traveling over 100 miles per hour in attempt to flee law enforcement. The suspects later crashed their vehicle into a guardrail near Cornelius Pass Rd. All three juveniles were lodged in the Cowlitz County Juvenile Detention Center.
