## EDC Goals for 2020-2021 with Updates

- 1. Support efforts to develop OMIC/PCC
  - a. PCC Training Center is expected to be completed and ready for a "soft-opening" in Spring 2021.
- 2. Focus on infrastructure needs of recently annexed land
  - a. The Basalt Well remains a critical infrastructure need, and the City continues work to develop this resource. The City is coordinating on an agreement to make the final connection of the road around the airport to Moore Road.
- 3. Support community events and increase community engagement Support Sauerkraut Festival, Chamber
  - a. Sauerkraut Festival Cancelled for 2020. Unlikely for 2021 with the upcoming centennial celebration.
- 4. Explore/Update City's land use development code for LI, EC, and C zones to allow brewpubs, microbreweries, micro-distilleries, and micro-wineries outright
  - a. Due to workload this goal was not accomplished this year. Planning Department work has not slowed down, and Staff will continue looking for opportunities to complete this work.
- 5. Scappoose Centennial Celebration 2021
  - a. Mayor Burge has formed an Ad Hoc Committee to plan this event and the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Peace Candle in 2021
- 6. Feasibility study for W Columbia Ave., consider adding to TSP
  - a. This feasibility study is included in the TSP and the Urban Renewal Plan. Committee has discussed this topic in detail in 2020.
- 7. Support light and intersection improvements at Wikstrom Road + HWY 30 intersection
  - a. No actions have been taken by Columbia County to improve this intersection. Scappoose will remain supportive of light and intersection improvements at this intersection.
