RESOLUTION 19-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DIRECT STAFF TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS IN PREPARING THE REFERRAL OF A \$0.03 LOCAL FUEL TAX TO THE NOVEMBER 2019 BALLOT.

Whereas, the City of Scappoose seeks to support the community's desire for a transportation system that supports community livability, accommodating residents and visitors in a safe, friendly, and affordable way; and

Whereas, the pavement condition index of Scappoose's street network is declining and under current insufficient funding; and

Whereas, 89% of respondents to the 2018 community survey think that the development and maintenance of sidewalks and roads is important in the scope of City services, and 92% of 2019 Annual Town Meeting attendees supported a local fuel tax as a transportation funding mechanism; and

Whereas, according to ODOT's most recent traffic volume figures, Scappoose experiences an average of 30,000 vehicle trips per day on US Highway 30 and approximately 10,000,000 gallons of fuel are sold annually within city limits, far exceeding fuel consumption based on Scappoose's population and commuter dynamics; and

Whereas, it is estimated that a \$0.03 local fuel tax would cost the average Scappoose commuter \$1.25 per month, thus most of the revenue burden will be placed on visitors and pass-through traffic; and

Whereas, the City of Scappoose has an annual additional need of approximately \$300,000 – which can be met by a \$0.03 local fuel tax – for paving projects and identified high-priority transportation infrastructure projects from the City's Transportation System Plan.

Now, therefore, be it resolved:

Section 1: The Scappoose City Council hereby demonstrates its support for the preparation of the referral of a local fuel tax to the November 2019 ballot.

Section 2: The Scappoose City Council authorizes the City Manager to direct staff to make all necessary preparations for the ballot referral.
