RESOLUTION NO. 22-10

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE'S WASTEWATER RATES AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 15-07

WHEREAS, Chapter 9, Section 32 of the Scappoose City Charter states the City shall have the authority to assess fees and charges for water, sewer, and other public facilities and services as are allowed by ordinance and state law, and such fees and charges may be enforced as liens on property as provided by ordinance.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 585 (May, 1992) allows for wastewater rates; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 19-02, the City of Scappoose entered into a financing contract with the Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority of the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) to obtain financial assistance from the Safe Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund to finance the Wastewater Treatment Plant Phase 1 improvements; and,

WHEREAS, ARTICLE 5(B)(2) of the financing contract authorized by Resolution No. 19-02 stipulates that "the Borrower shall review its wastewater rates and fees at least annually. If, in any fiscal year, the Borrower fails to collect fees sufficient to meet the debt service coverage requirements described in ARTICLE 5(B)(1), the Borrower shall promptly adjust its wastewater rates and fees to assure future compliance with such coverage requirement;" and,

WHEREAS, the Scappoose City Council has adopted wastewater master plans which include lists of proposed operational and capital improvements which affect wastewater rates; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a work session concerning wastewater rates on April 18, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the schedule of wastewater rates hereinafter specified and established are just, reasonable, and necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

Section 1: Scope of amendment and update of wastewater rates. The wastewater rates, fees, and service charges established by this Resolution are separate from, and in addition to, any other applicable taxes, fees, assessments, or charges, including but not limited to system development charges, which are required by the City of Scappoose or represent a condition of a land use or development approval. The updated schedule of wastewater rates for residential, commercial, and industrial users is attached hereto as **Schedule A**.

Section 2: Review. This Resolution may be reviewed at the discretion of the City Council, and the rates may be amended as appropriate.

Section 3: Index. The City Council has determined that the wastewater base charge and commodity rates shall increase annually by 7% for each of the next five fiscal years – or the Engineering News

Record (ENR) 20-City Average Construction Cost Index (CCI), whichever is greater – in order to meet the City's debt service requirements pursuant to the City's Safe Drinking Water Revolving Fund Loan authorized by Resolution No. 19-02.

Section 4: Repeal of prior resolution. Resolution No. 15-07 is hereby rescinded effective July 1, 2022.

Section 5: Effective Date. The rates in **Schedule A** adopted by this Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
