# **RESOLUTION NO. 24-12**

# ADOPTING THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE BUDGET, MAKING APPROPRIATIONS, DECLARING THE AD VALOREM TAX LEVY, AND CLASSIFYING THE LEVY AS PROVIDED BY ORS 310.060(2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council, following a Public Hearing on June 17, 2024, hereby adopts the budget for the City of Scappoose fiscal year 2024-2025 in the total of \$62,647,857 now on file at the office of the City Manager, City Hall, 33568 East Columbia Avenue, Scappoose OR 97056.
