ORDINANCE NO. 704

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESERVE FUND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A FISH LADDER AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE GOURLAY CREEK DAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to ORS 294.525, a Reserve Fund is hereby created for the accrual of revenue, and the expenditure appropriations for construction of a fish ladder and improvements to the Gurlay Creek Dam. The Reserve Fund is to be funded pursuant to the receipt of grants and subsequent agreements between the City, Bonneville Power Administration, Department of Energy, the Scappoose Bay Watershed Council and other funding agencies as the project progresses.

Section 2. The Fund's purpose is to fund the preliminary design, engineering, ESA/Environmental Application Processes and construction of a proposed fish passageway as approved by the agencies previously addressed.

Section 3. The City shall receive and disburse grant funds for purposes stipulated in the grant and for the benefit of the City of Scappoose. Specifically, the funds will be utilized to build a fish passage facility on the city-owned Gourlay Creek dam/reservoir. This objective will demand yet another list of "specific task" objectives that will require finalization within the design and engineering phase of the project. While specific construction objectives will be finalized through professional consultation and within state and federal guidelines, those described within Part 1, Section 2 of the grant request, should be considered within this ordinance as follows:

- Provide fish passage at Gourlay Creek Dam
- Restore downstream habitat on Gourlay Creek
- Initiate annual water quality monitoring procedures and surveys
- Install staff monitoring gauges at and up stream of new facility
- Provide ongoing facility monitoring, maintenance and updating

Section 4. The funds collected for the work described in Sections 2 and 3 shall be reserved generally for construction and collateral improvements to the Gourlay Creek Dam. The City may, at its discretion, apply additional funds in order to obtain funding from other state and/or federal funding sources.

Section 5. During the fiscal year 2003/2004, the City Council shall review the Reserve Fund to determine whether the fund will be continued or abolished. The Reserve Fund shall not be abolished until the "grant approved" construction and improvements have been completed. If the fund is abolished, any remaining balance that has not been obligated shall revert to and become a part of the Water Fund.
