ORDINANCE NO. 713

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO URBAN FORESTRY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERSHIP AND AMENDING SECTION 2.32 OF TITLE 2 OF THE SCAPPOOSE MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Scappoose Municipal Code Title 2 be amended as described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto.

EXHIBIT "A"

(Language to be omitted is strikethrough, language additions are in **bold italics**)

"2.32.030 Membership. Membership in the urban forestry advisory board shall consist of five seven members appointed by the mayor with the consent of the city council. Any vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the mayor, with the consent of the city council for the unexpired term of the predecessor in office. All members of the board shall be registered voters. Three m Members shall reside within the City of Scappoose.; and one member shall be the owner of a business adjacent to Highway 30; and one member shall a professional in the field of urban forestry. No more than two board members shall be in the same business, trade and/or profession. Board members shall receive no compensation; it is strictly a volunteer position. The Urban Forestry Advisory Board may solicit input and advice as necessary from experts within the field of urban forestry or a closely related field. However, such individuals shall be non-voting participants.
