

ORDINANCE NO. 834

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARKING WITHIN THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE
AND AMENDING SCAPPOOSE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 11.04.170.**

THE SCAPPOOSE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, parking enforcement is a public safety issue; and

WHEREAS, having to indicate “no parking zones” with signage is costly to the City;
and

WHEREAS, yellow painted curbs are commonly recognized as “no parking zones,” but
are not yet enforceable under the Scappoose Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Scappoose wishes to indicate a “no parking zone” with a yellow
painted curb.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 11.04.170 of the Scappoose Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:
(*Omitted language is in ~~strikethrough~~, proposed language is underlined*)

J. A vehicle in a “NO PARKING” zone that has been designated as such by signage
posted or by a curb which has been painted yellow and stenciled, indicating it has been
authorized by the city ~~and posted as prescribed by the city.~~
