

ORDINANCE NO. 844

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA
BY LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES IN THE CITY OF
SCAPPOOSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 460 (2015) allows medical marijuana dispensaries to sell recreational marijuana in limited amounts to persons at least 21 years of age beginning October 1, 2015 ("early sales");

WHEREAS, a city may adopt an ordinance prohibiting early sales within the city limits through December 31, 2016 when SB 460 is automatically repealed; and

WHEREAS, the Scappoose City Council desires to prohibit early sales and prevent medical marijuana dispensaries from selling recreational marijuana and other retail marijuana products;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Senate Bill 460 (2015), early sales of limited marijuana retail products, as described in SB 460, is prohibited in the City of Scappoose.


SECTION 2. This ordinance automatically expires and is to be deemed repealed at 11:59:59 p.m. on December 31, 2016, unless sooner repealed or extended by City Council ordinance.

SECTION 3. With the statutory start date for early sales of October 1, 2015, this ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, safety, and general welfare; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.
