

**ORDINANCE NO. 853**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ADOPTION OF STATE CRIMINAL STATUTES  
AND AMENDING SCAPPOOSE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 9.08.**

**THE SCAPPOOSE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, the state criminal statutes are enforceable under the Scappoose Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, updating the current Scappoose Municipal Code will allow the City of Scappoose to remain current on the criminal statutes set forth by Oregon Legislation.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 9.08 was last updated in 2005.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 9.08.010 of the Scappoose Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

9.08.010 Adoption of Statutes. A. Pursuant to the authority granted in ORS ~~221.229~~  
(~~2~~) 221.339 (2), the following statutory provisions are hereby adopted by reference is as if fully  
set forth herein: ORS Chapters 161, 162, 163, 164, 165, 166 and 167 (Oregon Criminal Code);  
ORS Chapters 471, 474 and 475 (related to liquor and controlled substances); ORS 153.008  
(violation described); and ORS 153.018 (schedule of penalties), ~~as such provisions were~~  
~~amended by 2005 Oregon Legislature.~~ as adopted and may be subsequently amended, modified  
or otherwise enacted by the Oregon Legislature.

B. This section shall not apply to any statutory provision relating to the creation and  
prosecution of a felony, or to any provision expressly precluded by law from being ~~foreed~~  
enforced by a municipality.
