## **RESOLUTION NO. 09-02**

## A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT TO DEVELOP DESIGN CONCEPTS FOR THE HIGHWAY 30 SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Scappoose recognizes the importance of creating a livable community and the importance of safe pedestrian walkways along the Highway 30 corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Scappoose recognizes that the sidewalk along the western side of Highway 30 is in a state of disrepair primarily due to the placement of street trees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Scappoose recognizes that urban design plays a vital role in defining a community's identity; and

WHEREAS, the City of Scappoose recognizes the importance of seeking grant funds to evaluate alternative design concepts that are aesthetically pleasing and accessible to all pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Growth Management Program of the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development awards grants to local governments for projects that support compact, mixed-use, pedestrian-friendly development and increase opportunities for transit, walking and cycling; now therefore


## THE SCAPPOOSE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Council supports the City's 2009 Transportation and Growth Management Grant Application to develop and evaluate design alternatives for the sidewalk on the west side of Highway 30 and commits to dedicating the necessary staff resources for the implementation of the project if the grant request is approved.
- 2. If the grant request is successful, the Council authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into all contracts necessary to secure the grant.
