

**Resolution No. 17-18**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR A 319 NONPOINT  
SOURCE IMPLEMENTATION GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF  
ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR FUNDS TO APPLY TO THE STORM-WATER  
MASTER PLAN PROJECT AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO SIGN  
THE APPLICATION.

**Whereas,** the Department of Environmental Quality is accepting applications for the  
319 Nonpoint Source Implementation Grant; and

**Whereas,** the City of Scappoose desires to participate in this grant program to the  
greatest extent possible as a means of providing funding to the Storm-Water Master Plan Project;  
and

**Whereas,** the Scappoose City Council has identified the development of a long term  
comprehensive community vision as a high priority need in the City of Scappoose; and

**Whereas,** completing the Storm-Water Master Plan will ensure Scappoose meets  
state mandated requirements requiring cities to maintain 20-year horizon planning documents;  
and

**Whereas,** the City needs an updated Storm-Water Master Plan to address current and  
future storm-water deficiencies; and

**Whereas,** City funds have already been allocated to the Storm-Water Master Plan  
project and meet the matching requirements of the grant.


**Now, therefore, be it resolved:**

The Scappoose City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for a 319  
Nonpoint Source Implementation Grant on behalf of the City for the Storm-Water Master Plan  
Project and authorizes the Mayor to sign the grant application.
