

## RESOLUTION NO. 12-04

### A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EXPLORATION OF AN APPLICATION FOR AN OREGON REGIONALLY SIGNIFICANT INDUSTRIAL SITE DESIGNATION

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Legislature established legislation in 2011 under SB-766 to designate 5 to 15 regionally significant industrial sites and create a process for concurrent processing and permitting in 120 days; and

**WHEREAS**, the Economic Recovery Review Council (ERRC) is accepting applications for Regionally Significant Industrial Sites; and

**WHEREAS**, Columbia-Pacific Economic Development District, the region's federally designated economic development district, is contemplating submitting a proposal to establish a Columbia River West Industrial Corridor (CRWIC) from Scappoose to Tongue Point as a regionally significant industrial site; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Scappoose has reviewed this draft concept and concurs that CRWIC includes industrial properties in the Scappoose community that meet the allowable uses for the site; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Scappoose provides water and sewer services to industrial properties once developers construct the necessary infrastructure; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Scappoose, in cooperation with the Oregon Department of Employment and Management Training Corporation (MTC), supports specific training needed for employees working at selected industrial sites.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Scappoose City Council endorses the development of an application, and agrees to provide Columbia-Pacific Economic Development District and the Economic Recovery Review Council additional information required to assist in the certification of the project.
