

RESOLUTION 15-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR A TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT FOR FUNDS TO COMPLETE A BUILDABLE LANDS INVENTORY AND HOUSING NEEDS ANALYSIS AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.

Whereas, the Department of Land Conservation and Development is accepting applications for Technical Assistance Grants; and

Whereas, the City of Scappoose desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of acquiring needed funding to hire a consultant to perform a Buildable Lands Inventory and Housing Needs Analysis; and

Whereas, the City needs the information that a Buildable Lands Inventory and Housing Needs Analysis will provide in order to understand its residential land needs for the next 20 year planning period, and without this grant the City would not be able to hire a consultant to perform these studies; and

Whereas, the City hereby certifies that the \$10,000 matching share for this application is readily available at this time.

Now, therefore, be it resolved:

The Scappoose City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for a Technical Assistance Grant from the Department of Land Conservation and Development on behalf of the City for a Buildable Lands Inventory and Housing Needs Analysis and authorizes the Mayor to sign the grant application.
