

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-04**

**A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING CITY OWNED PROPERTY AS A PARK AND NAMING IT TOMEE PARK.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Scappoose adopted the Parks, Trails and Open Space Master Plan the Summer of 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the conceptual designs contained in the Master Plan identify tax lots 1100 and 1300, historically referred to as the "Seely Lane" properties, as the site of a future City Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded grant funds from the Oregon Parks and Recreation in the amount of \$442,680.00 to develop a park on tax lots 1100 and 1300; and

**WHEREAS**, the City held a Park Naming contest; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Ordinance 661 adopting rules and regulations for governing parks and requiring designation of parks by Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**


The properties identified as tax lots 1100 and 1300, identified in Exhibit A, shall be known as Tomee Park.
