

RESOLUTION NO. 18-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCAPPOOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR A REGIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND GRANT MADE AVAILABLE BY THE REGIONAL SOLUTIONS PROGRAM OF BUSINESS OREGON FOR FUNDS TO APPLY TO THE WAGNER COURT WASTEWATER LINE UPSIZING PROJECT AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.

Whereas, the Regional Solutions Program is accepting applications for the Regional Infrastructure Fund; and

Whereas, the City of Scappoose desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing funding to the Wager Court Wastewater Line Upsizing Project; and

Whereas, the Scappoose City Council has identified economic development as a high priority need in the City of Scappoose; and

Whereas, completing this project will have a positive economic impact on the community by increasing the capacity of existing infrastructure to support new industrial development; and

Whereas, this project will assist in the development of OMIC and other industrially zoned property in the NE section of Scappoose; and

Whereas, there are no matching funds required by this grant program

Now, therefore, be it resolved:

The Scappoose City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for a Regional Infrastructure Fund Grant made available by the Regional Solutions Program of Business Oregon on behalf of the City for Wagner Court Wastewater Line Upsizing Project and authorizes the Mayor to sign the grant application.
