Minutes

1. Dave Powers called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm

- 1.1. Joel requested to add 2.7 Venue for July
- 1.2. The meeting minutes from April were approved without modifications.
- 1.3. No public comment.

2. City Updates and Discussion

2.1 Garett explained how the City wants to update the Parks and Rec Committee by-laws to better reflect the City's code. Garett explained how it is just cleaning up the language, but it doesn't drastically change the structure of the group. The committee approved and adopted the new bylaws. Garett also informed the group that the City Council is going to reappoint everyone for a



- second term, but they're going to stagger the terms from 1-3 years so everyone won't come up for reelection at the same time again. Everyone agreed that it would be fine.
- Alex updated everyone on the progress of the logging operations at Bella Vista. He said Trout Mountain recommended a logging company and they are placing a bid soon. She will update the committee when she gets more information. Alex is also going to apply to the NPS grant to help with the trail plan.
- 2.3 The name for "Seely Park" has officially been changed to Chief Concomley Park. The City also received a bid for the construction and it came in too high so the City is working to renegotiate with the company. The company said they might be able to reduce the cost if they extend the time frame.
- 2.4 Dave was not present to give a parks update. Garett brought up how the foundation is using too much water and that the fountain used 340,000 gallons in one month. He informed the Committee that the City is planning on reducing the water usage. The Committee suggested the City just turns on the water for select times of the day like 2-5 pm to maximize the splash area for parents and children. Garett said he would tell the City Manager the Committee's recommendation.
- 2.5 The Columbia Century Challenge was a successful event and everyone was happy with the way it turned out. Many members of the committee volunteered for the event. They said that they enjoyed it but it was a lot of work. Most seamed open to volunteering again next year.
- 2.6 Garett updated the group that the next Friends of Scappoose Meeting would be held after the Parks Committee.
- 2.7 Joel suggested that the next meeting we meet at Marks on the Channel for food and then go kayaking afterwards. Everyone seemed open to the idea.
