Swofford Excavating LLC. will start the construction of the Oak and Myrtle Waterline replacement the week of March 13, 2025. With an anticipated start date of 03/17/25. Construction is anticipated to be completed in April 2025. The work will include the placement of a New 8" water main associated laterals and two tie-in points on Oak Street and on Myrtle Street.

During this time, portions of Oak and Myrtle Street will have temporary traffic control measures in place, with signage. This will include roads closed to thru traffic and one-lane roads through the intersections of 3rd and Oak, 3rd and Myrtle, 4th and Oak, and 4th and Myrtle. This will help route traffic and pedestrians safely around the construction site and work zone.

We plan to complete the proposed work on Myrtle and Oak Street within 4-5 weeks of the start date. We will be doing our best to get traffic through and around each work zone as quickly and safely as possible. We will also accommodate any residences or businesses affected by the construction and will guide them through the work zone, if necessary, to reach their destination.

Swofford Excavating LLC. recognizes that temporary delays and the closure of one lane at the intersections of Oak and Myrtle may cause an inconvenience, but this is necessary to facilitate construction and provide for both the public's safety and the safety of construction personnel.

As we move forward with the project, we will continue to provide updates on the construction along with any changes to traffic control. Please keep in mind that interruptions and delays in construction do occur, and our schedule can change weekly and, at times, from day to day.

Please obey all construction signs and our flagger directions (or construction personnel directions). Our flagging personnel are happy to help. Please be safe and drive slowly and carefully through our work zones. We ask that you be aware of our construction workers and the equipment they are operating since they are focused on the work at hand. Thank you for your understanding, cooperation, and patience. Please know that we will do our best to provide the community of Scappoose with a quality project in a timely and safe manner.
